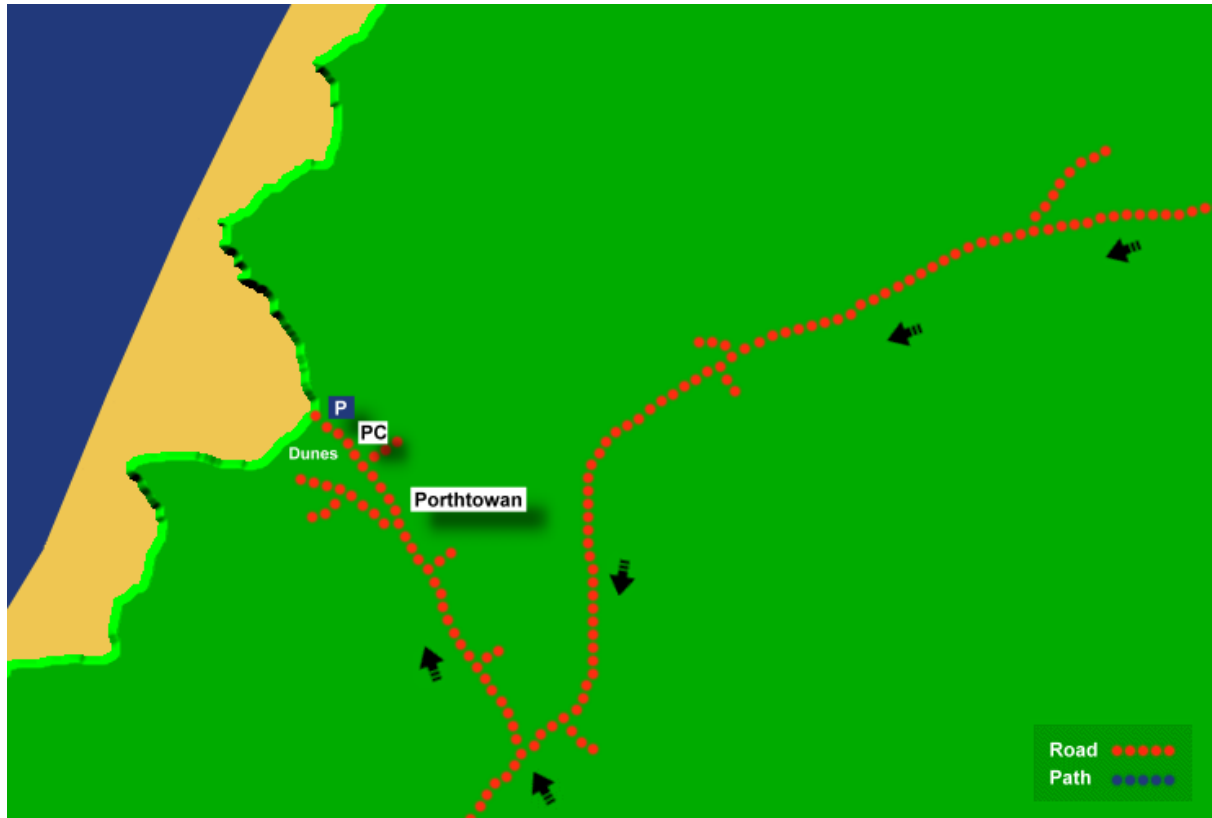


Porthtowan Beach



- Description:Porthtowan Beach is a large sandy beach popular with surfers and families
- Safety:Lifeguards in summer at Porthtowan Beach
- Access:The car park is close to Porthtowan Beach. There is level access to the beach
- Dogs:Dogs are banned on Porthtowan Beach from Easter Day to October 1
- Directions:Porthtowan Beach is 9 miles from Truro and 15 miles from Newquay. Use the A30 from the east or west. At the Chiverton Cross roundabout (about 8 miles from Redruth) turn onto the B3277 the road to St Agnes (signposted to St Agnes). After about 2 miles turn left at a crossroads (signposted to Porthtowan) and follow this road for several miles to Porthtowan. Arriving in Porthtowan, turn right where signposted to Porthtowan and follow this road to the Porthtowan Beach car park
- Parking:One large car park at Porthtowan, plus some road parking
- Toilets:Yes, in the Porthtowan Beach car park
- Facilities:Beach shop and cafe near the beach at Porthtowan
- Activities:Surfing at Porthtowan

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
